




#### **Breach of Peace**

St Mary's Hospital security staff reported a known female refusing to leave the premises and being verbally aggressive. Police located and arrested the female to prevent further breach of peace. The female was released later and served a trespass notice to St. Mary's Hospital unless requiring medical treatment.

#### Vehicle taken without consent

A person reported her vehicle was taken without consent by a known male. The vehicle was later reported abandoned by Lloydminster RCMP and subsequently towed.

#### **Motor Vehicle collisions**

A collision occurred between two motor vehicles at Grand Drive and 49 Avenue. The operator of one of the vehicles was charged with following too close.

A collision occurred between two vehicles at 6800 block and 49 Avenue. The operator of one vehicle was charged with failing to proceed safely after stopping.

#### Possible relationship scam

A person reported that a friend may be the victim of a relationship scam online, involving an alleged Brazilian dancer who needed money for bail.

#### Erratic driving causing damage to property

A person reported three trucks driving erratically in the parking lot of the Smith Clinic/Duggan Mall. As a result of the erratic driving rocks were thrown up and broke the glass in the two front doors of the clinic. The person reporting provided licence plate numbers to the police who in turn contacted the registered owners and determined the operators of the trucks.

#### Possible fraud

A person reported a possible fraud involving the purchase of a vehicle from a company in Texas. The person reporting indicated that they had sent funds for the truck but a year and a half later had not received the vehicle and were still receiving requests for more money from the alleged company.

#### Garage fire

Police attended and assisted Camrose Fire Department with a residential garage fire. The fire was extinguished by CFD and the garage was boarded up.

#### Possession of knife

St. Mary's Hospital security staff reported detaining a male suspect in possession of a knife. Police attended and identified the suspect who displayed signs of intoxication. The suspect was arrested and charged with Possession of a Weapon for Dangerous Purpose and Possession under the Controlled Drugs and Substance Act.

#### Causing issues at hospital

St. Mary's Hospital staff reported a male who was causing issues. Police attended and dealt with the male. On a separate occurrence later that day a St. Mary's Hospital nurse reported that the male had come close to assaulting another nurse.

#### **Acting suspicious**

A person reported a male suspect acting suspicious and smoking inside of a local business. Police attended and located the male suspect in the storage area of the business. Police determined the suspect had a 24-hour curfew and order "not to be intoxicated." The suspect was arrested and charged.

#### **Collision**

A collision occurred between two vehicles (semi truck and passenger truck towing a utility trailer) at the intersection of 73 street and 48 Avenue. The incident momentarily delayed traffic moving westbound on Highway 13 until the semi could be moved. Charges are pending for the operator of the passenger truck regarding an unsafe turn into traffic. No injuries were reported.

#### Stolen firearm

Police conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for an equipment violation. Police observed open liquor in the vehicle and a subsequent search revealed a carbine rifle, quantity of cash, cocaine and drug paraphernalia. The operator of the vehicle (suspect) was arrested for unauthorized possession of a firearm. Checks of the firearm determined it was stolen out of Flagstaff County. The vehicle was towed and the suspect charged with numerous firearm offences, possession of a controlled substance and possession of proceeds of crime.

"Crow," said the little girl.



#### These Southern deviled eggs will be the hit of your New Year's Eve party

Deviled eggs are the perfect party food. Set a platter of them on a buffet, and you can safely assume they'll be gone in minutes — such is the appeal of a good deviled egg. But if I had one small quibble to make with the traditional recipe, it would be this: Deviled eggs could use a little crunch.

Enter: deep-fried deviled eggs. They've got the same tangy, velvety filling we know and love, but in the upgrade of all upgrades, they also boast a crispy, golden-brown, panko-coated fried egg white that gives them that much-needed extra crunch. The only danger with these deviled eggs is that once you've made them this way, you might not be able to go back to the classic ever again.

#### Deep-Fried Deviled Eggs (Makes 12, serves 6)

8 large eggs, divided

1/4 cup mayonnaise

2 teaspoons Dijon mustard

1 teaspoon apple cider vinegar

3/4 teaspoon kosher salt, divided, plus more as needed

1 1/2 cups vegetable or peanut oil, for frying

3/4 cup all-purpose flour

1/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper, plus more as needed

1 cup panko breadcrumbs

1/4 cup grated Parmesan cheese

1 tablespoon finely chopped fresh chives (optional)

Paprika, for sprinkling (optional)



- 1. Place six of the large eggs in a medium saucepan and add enough cold water to cover the eggs by about 1 inch. Bring to a boil over high heat. Remove the saucepan from the heat. Cover and let sit for 10 minutes. Meanwhile, prepare an ice water bath by filling a large bowl halfway with ice and water.
- 2. When the eggs are ready, remove them from the hot water. Tap each egg against the counter to crack the shell in a few places. Transfer to the ice water bath and let sit until cool, at least 2 minutes.
- 3. Remove the eggs from the water and peel. Halve the eggs lengthwise. Carefully remove the yolks and transfer to a small bowl. Place the egg whites in a single layer on a large plate or baking sheet.
- 4. Use a fork to mash the yolks as finely as possible. Stir in 1/4 cup mayonnaise, 2 teaspoons Dijon mustard, 1 teaspoon apple cider vinegar, and 1/4 teaspoon of the kosher salt. Taste and season with black pepper and more kosher salt as needed.
- 5. Transfer the filling to a small plastic bag or piping bag (fit first with a 1/2-inch round or star tip if desired). If using a plastic bag, snip off one bottom corner.
- 6. Heat 1 1/2 cups vegetable oil in a 10-inch heavy-bottomed, high-sided skillet over medium-high heat until 350 F.
- 7. Meanwhile, stir 3/4 cup all-purpose flour, the remaining 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt, and 1/4 teaspoon black pepper together in a wide, shallow bowl with a fork. Beat the remaining two large eggs in a second wide, shallow bowl with the fork. Stir 1 cup panko breadcrumbs and 1/4 cup grated Parmesan cheese together in a third bowl.
- 8. Working with a few egg whites at a time, dredge in the flour mixture until evenly coated. Then, working with one piece at a time, shake off the excess flour and dredge in the eggs, then the panko mixture, gently pressing the breadcrumbs into the egg white so they stick. Return to the plate.
- 9. Fry four pieces at a time: Add the breaded egg whites to the hot oil and fry, flipping them halfway through, until browned and crisp all over, 1 to 2 minutes total. Use a slotted spoon or spider to transfer them to a paper towel-lined plate cut-side down. Let cool to room temperature, about 5 minutes.
- 10. Flip the fried egg whites over. Pipe the filling evenly among the fried egg whites (about 1 heaping table-spoon per deviled egg). Garnish with 1 tablespoon finely chopped fresh chives and a sprinkle of paprika if desired. These are best consumed shortly after frying.



#### Get it Built!

Late last month, Prime Minister Mark Carney signed a "Memorandum of Understanding" ("MOU") with the Government of Alberta. Key to that agreement was "a priority to have a pipeline to Asia that's going to make Canada stronger, more independent, more resilient, more sustainable."






