If you've only seen Trevor's original act, you will see him in a different light with his tribute to one of his heroes. Trevor and the band share familiar renditions and new interpretations of the music of one of the most beloved artists of all time. the "original" gentle giant, Don Williams. Trevor will take you through the decades connecting


