Telephone scam

A person reported being scammed out of \$7,500 through a telephone scam where the caller claimed to be with the Bank of Montreal.

Collision

A person reported a collision at 4911 50 Street, where an unoccupied motor vehicle struck a retail business window. While police were on route to the site of the incident, the operator of the subject vehicle returned and later provided information to the police.

Erratic driving

Police conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle that was being operated erratically. The operator of the vehicle showed no signs of impairment but was charged with a traffic offence. A relative of the operator was called to scene to drive the operator home.

Collision

A person reported a collision with the vehicle they were operating when another vehicle moved into their lane and struck their vehicle. Police determined the damage to the reporting person's vehicle was under \$1,000. The matter was settled between the operators of both vehicles.

Assault

A person reported being assaulted by a known suspect who had broken into the reporting person's residence and stole some items. The person reporting indicated the suspect was in possession of a BB rifle and BB handgun.

Erratic driving

A person reported two vehicles driving erratically. Police located the subject vehicles. The operator of one of the vehicles was given a Field Sobriety Test resulting in a fail. The operator was charged with careless driving and issued an Administrative Penalty Information System driving suspension. The vehicle was towed. The operator of the other vehicle was charged with careless driving.

Unregistered/uninsured vehicle

Police conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for vehicle equipment concerns (use of dealer licence plates.) Police determined the vehicle, which was recently purchased by the operator, had not been properly insured and registered as per requirements after purchase. The operator was charged, the dealer licence plate was seized and the vehicle was towed.

Misuse of licence plates

Police conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for misuse of licence plates. The operator of the vehicle was charged with invalid insurance.

Collision

A two motor vehicle collision occurred at 51 Street and 48 Avenue.

Police would like to remind citizens to slow down and use extreme caution especially during inclement weather conditions when roads become very hazardous.

DECEMBER 16-31, 2025

Collisions

A person reported their vehicle was struck while stopped at the intersection of 51 Street and 48 Avenue, by a vehicle travelling westbound turning north at the intersection. The operator of the subject vehicle left the scene.

A person reported their vehicle was struck while parked at the Duggan Mall parking lot causing \$8,000 damage.

Pedestrian struck

A person reported being struck by a vehicle while walking their dog. Police and EMS attended. EMS treated the victim (pedestrian). The operator of the subject vehicle was charged with fail to remain on scene and unsafe left turn.

Crypto fraud

A person reported being the victim of a crypto currency fraud. The subject of the fraud (reporting person) indicated they invested an initial \$80,000 and when they attempted to withdraw from the investment they were told they would have to pay an additional \$40,000 to access any funds. When the reporting person refused the alleged fraudsters became verbally aggressive.

Causing issues

A person reported a male suspect causing issues. Police attended the residence and determined the suspect had punched another male and damaged their property. Police located and arrested the suspect and charged them with two breaches.

Traffic stop

Police conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for a driving offence. Police determined the vehicle was unregistered and uninsured and the operator had a suspended driver's licence. The operator was charged and the vehicle was towed.

Intoxication in public place

Staff of a local restaurant reported a female suspect causing issues and not having valid identification. Police located and arrested the suspect for intoxication in a public place.






2025 In Review: Standing Strong for Canadians

As 2025 draws to a close, we have a chance to reflect on a remarkable year in the history of our province and our nation.

In the last federal election, Conservatives were proud to bring Canadians a message of hope. 

Boston cream brownies are the boxed mix hack anyone can make

If I had to choose just one dessert to eat for the rest of time, I'd pick brownies. They are rich, chewy (or cakey, if that's your preference), and chocolate-y. They're a cinch to make from scratch, and even easier to make from a boxed mix. In fact, brownie mix is one of the few baking mixes that I consistently keep on hand for quick and easy after-dinner treats.

Brownie batter takes just minutes to make, so I spend the rest of my baking time dreaming up new flavor mash-ups. An idea struck when I saw Molly Allen's Boston cream pie bars. I couldn't get over the thick, pudgy layer of vanilla custard and the rich chocolate topping. The only thing that could make these bars better in my mind was to assemble them on a brownie base, so that's what I did to make Boston cream brownies. If you love brownies as much as I do, this takes them up to the next level.

Key ingredients in Boston cream brownies

Boxed brownie mix: Use your favorite boxed brownie mix and grab the ingredients listed to make the batter on the package. Depending on the brand, you may need vegetable oil or melted butter, water or milk, and an egg or two.

Instant vanilla pudding mix: Use 3 (3.4-ounce) boxes of instant vanilla pudding mix instead of homemade pastry cream to make this dessert even easier. Make sure to buy the instant variety and not cook and serve.

Semi-sweet chocolate chips: Semi-sweet chocolate chips are the base of the rich ganache layer.

Heavy cream: Stir some of the heavy cream into the instant pudding mix for the custard layer, then heat the rest until simmering and pour over chocolate for the ganache.

Corn syrup: This ingredient (which isn't the same as high fructose corn syrup) gives the ganache a glossy finish.

Boston Cream Brownies (Serves 24)

1 (16- to 18-ounce) box brownie mix

Vegetable oil or butter, water or milk, and eggs needed for brownie mix (see package directions)

3 (3.4-ounce) boxes instant vanilla pudding mix

4 3/4 cups cold heavy cream, divided

1 1/2 cups semi-sweet chocolate chips (about 9 ounces)

1/4 cup light corn syrup



Make the brownie layer:

1. Heat the oven to 325 F. Generously coat a 9-by-13-inch baking pan with cooking spray. Line the bottom and sides of the pan with two pieces of overlapping parchment paper, arranging them perpendicular to each other so that the paper extends over all four sides by a few inches.

2. Prepare the batter from 1 (17- to 18-ounce) box brownie mix according to the package directions. Transfer to the baking pan and smooth out the top.

3. Bake until the top is dry and smooth and a tester inserted into the center comes out clean, about 25 minutes. Place on a rack and let cool for at least 1 hour.

Make the custard and ganache:

1. Whisk 3 (3.4-ounce) boxes instant vanilla pudding mix and 3 3/4 cups of the cold heavy cream together in a large bowl until smooth; it will be very thick. Spread evenly over the brownie layer. Refrigerate for at least 10 minutes. After about 5 minutes, make the ganache.

2. Place 1 1/2 cups semi-sweet chocolate chips and 1/4 cup light corn syrup in a medium heat-proof bowl. Bring the remaining 1 cup heavy cream to a full simmer in a small saucepan over medium heat. Pour over the chocolate and let it sit for 1 minute. Whisk until the chocolate is melted and the ganache is smooth.

3. Let cool for 3 minutes if you'd like to pour on the ganache for a smooth finish, or let cool for 5 minutes if you'd like to make a swooping pattern in the ganache.

4. Pour the ganache over the custard in an even layer. Use the back of a spoon or butter knife to make a swooping pattern in the ganache if desired. Refrigerate until set, at least 2 hours. Grasping the excess parchment, lift the slab out of the pan and place on a cutting board. Cut into 24 pieces, wiping the knife clean between each cut for the cleanest-looking slices.


