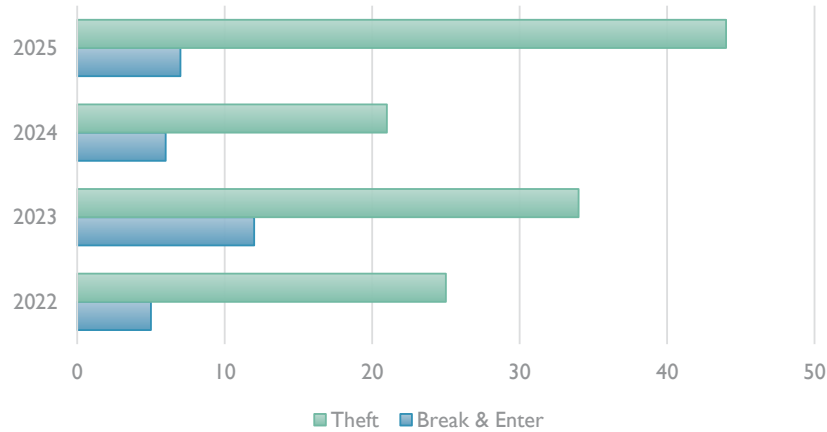

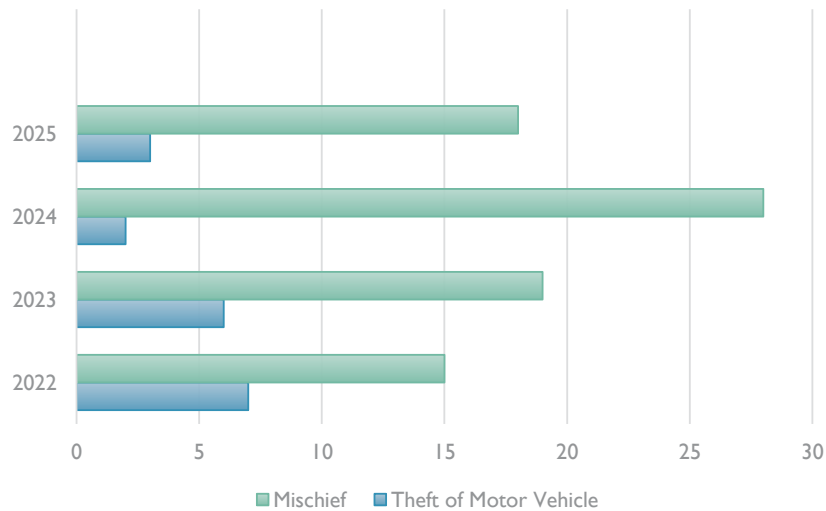

## WATER SHORTAGE

**We are currently in Stage 1 of our 4-stage water shortage response plan. The following MANDATORY water restrictions are in place:**

- Lawns may only be watered between 6AM to 9AM and 7PM to 11PM.
    - Odd-numbered houses may water only on odd-numbered days.
    - Even-numbered houses may water only on even-numbered days.
  - Only hand watering with a watering can or hose with trigger nozzle is allowed for flower and vegetable gardens.
  - Sprinklers and water toys may be used for recreational purposes by children as long as children are actively playing, including a pool with a capacity not more than 1,000 litres.
  - Decorative outdoor water features must be turned off.
- Stage 1 includes exemptions for newly laid sod.

***Any violation of these restrictions can result in fines.***

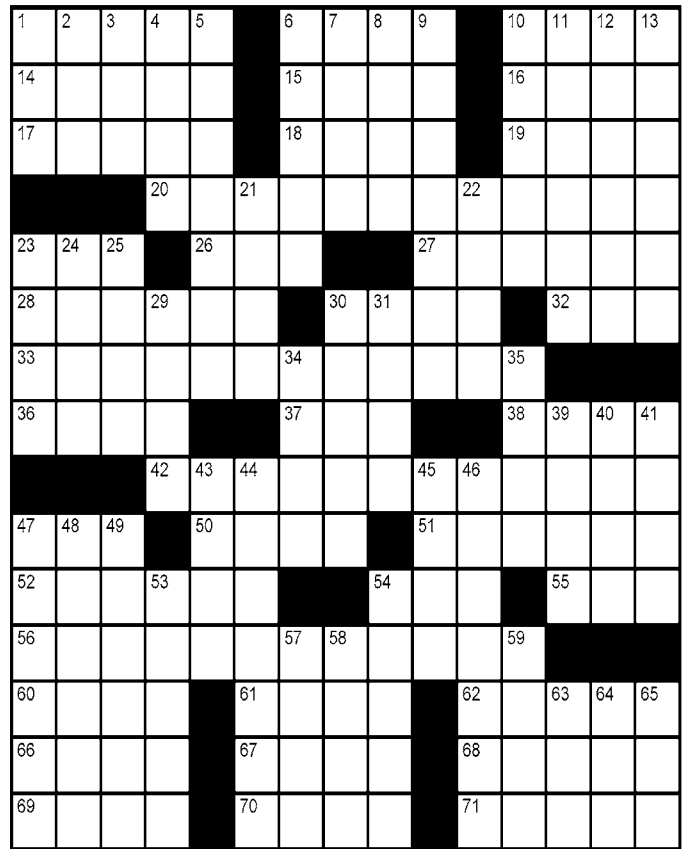

### THE WOODSHED

Acclaimed roots songwriters John Wort Hannam and T. Buckley make up The Woodshed, a modern folk duo based in Alberta, whose name refers to the beginning of Buckley and Hannam's collaboration - woodshedding songs together during a residency at the Banff Centre for Arts and Creativity in 2017.

After a captivating performance at the 2023 Canadian Folk Music Awards, Buckley and Hannam finally decided to ratify their collaboration and bring The Woodshed to life. Together they bring a beautiful vocal blend of brotherly harmonies combined with gutsy and sophisticated song writing alongside intricate guitar playing.

### JOHN WORT HANNAM

Alberta's John Wort Hannam has been on his roots-fueled troubadour journey for two decades, spinning song writing gold from the chaff of the lives he has encountered an within his fertile imagination. Twenty years into his career, he shows no sign of slowing down. In fact, he appears to be gaining both momentum and a wider audience. Winning two 2023 Canadian Folk Music Awards for Solo Artist of the Year and Contemporary Album of the Year. John has enjoyed a lifelong passion for singing and audiences and critics hear something special in his narrative, lyrically driven songs. Effortlessly mixing rich and clear timbered vocals with lyrics that tug at the heart, his sound is both unique and familiar.

Born on the island of Jersey in the UK, he immigrated to Canada at the age of nine, and like a lot of performers, John began his singing career in a choir - the Calgary Boys Choir. He later discovered the guitar and his knack for writing songs in his early thirties while working as a teacher on the Kainai Nation in Blackfoot country. In 2001, John quit his teaching job and made himself a promise - he would try his hand at writing songs for 10 months or until his employment insurance ran out. When time was up, if he had a handful of songs, he would record them. Those songs would become his first recording, Pocket Full of Holes, released in 2003. Twenty-one years later, the Alberta musician is recognized as one of the best folk roots songwriters in Alberta, has released 8 full length recordings, and has a few feathers in his hat that included a Juno Nomination, three Canadian Folk Music Awards, a coveted Kerrville, TX



New Folk Songwriting Competition win and numerous other Canadian Folk Music Award and Western Canadian Music Award nominations.

### T. BUCKLEY

Award-winning songwriter T. Buckley stands quietly among a disappearing ilk of true craftsmen. Shadowed by his Western roots, his soul and voice are unmistakably genuine, and the result is a class of songsmith long revered and scarcely achieved.

With influences stemming from the '60s Laurel Canyon and New York Cafe scenes, he tells stories embedded with detail, empathy and heart. Buckley's dedication to his art has seen him on renowned showcase and festival stages throughout North America.

Buckley's most recent album, "Frame by Frame," has been recognized through Canadian Folk Music Award and Western Canadian Music Award nominations, as well as a Calgary Music Award for best folk recording.

Versatility as a songwriter and musician have T. Buckley on the road in a variety of arrangements, rolling solo, collaborating with fellow Alberta songsmith John Wort Hannam as The Woodshed and performing with sibling songstress, Mariel Buckley. Perhaps the perfect vehicle to deliver Buckley's evocative narratives though, is his acoustic trio, whose tight harmonies and intricate arrangements captivate audiences wherever they perform.

## Summer fruit crisp with mascarpone custard is the season's best dessert

Recently I had a crowd over for a barbecue that included kids and adults. For dessert I did a reinterpretation of my favorite summer dessert: fruit crisp. Usually, a crisp is made with a layer of cut-up fruit and a streusel topping. This time I wanted to put a custard layer in the center for a subtle yet decidedly creamy surprise.

It was not only a hit with the adults, but 4-year-old Jack looked up at me and said "Diane, can you make this for me every day?" That certainly made my day.

In this fruit crisp update, I combined softened mascarpone cheese with eggs, vanilla and flour and spread it across the fruit mixture. Crowned with a brown sugar crisp topping, this is my vote for Summer's Best Dessert. Know that you can combine your favorite fruits together like pineapple, strawberries, plums or nectarines.

I have tested this in different ovens and sometimes it takes longer for the top to crisp and brown, so start looking at the crisp after 40 minutes to make sure it is cooked all the way through. If you want, you can gild the lily with a scoop of vanilla ice cream alongside the warm fruit dessert.

### Summer Fruit Crisp with Mascarpone Custard (Serves 6 to 8)

#### For the fruit:

- 1 1/2 cups raspberries (1 6-ounce package), cleaned and picked over
- 1 1/2 cups blueberries or blackberries (1 6-ounce package), cleaned and picked over
- 3 medium white or orange peaches, pitted and cut into 2-inch dice
- 1/2 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/4 cup sugar

#### For the custard:

- 2 eggs
- 8 ounces softened mascarpone cheese
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 tablespoon all-purpose flour

#### For the crisp topping:

- 6 tablespoons brown sugar
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon finely chopped lemon zest
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1/2 cup melted unsalted butter

1. Preheat the oven to 375 F.
2. In a mixing bowl mix together the fruit, 1/2 cup flour and 1/4 sugar until the fruit is well coated. Transfer to an 8-by-10 or a 9-by-12-inch greased gratin pan or baking dish. Press down with a spatula to make an even layer with no gaps. Place on a parchment-lined baking sheet.
3. For the custard: In a medium bowl with an electric mixer, beat the eggs well. Add the softened mascarpone and vanilla and beat until blended. Sift in the flour, whisking well to make sure the custard is smooth with no lumps. Set aside.
4. In a bowl mix together the brown sugar, flour, salt and lemon zest. Add the vanilla and melted butter; mix until it becomes a soft dough.
5. Spread an even layer of the custard cream mixture over the fruit. Crumble the dough mixture with your fingers evenly over the fruit. Bake for 40 to 50 minutes or until the top is golden brown and completely cooked through. Serve immediately or at room temperature.

**Make ahead:** This may be prepared 4 hours ahead, covered and kept at room temperature before serving. Reheat in a 375-degree oven for 10 minutes before serving.

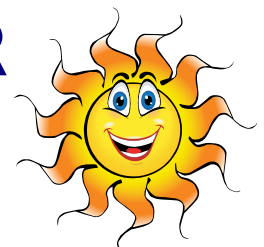

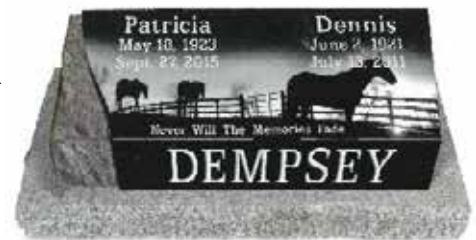
