Notable Incidents

Lost debit card

A person reported their debit card was lost and since two (unauthorized) transactions occurred. The card was cancelled through the bank and the matter remains under investigation.

Barking dog

A person reported a neighbour's dog was barking excessively. Police attended and spoke with a male at the subject residence, who indicated he was caring for the dogs until the next day when they would return to their owner's residence.

Causing issues

A representative of a local motel reported a male subject was evicted from the property but was refusing to leave. Police attended and told the 52-year-old male to leave the premises. The male left and continued to return on several occasions. The male was charged initially under the Trespass Act and eventually arrested for obstruction.

Theft

A Loss Prevention Officer from a local retail business reported having several individuals under arrest for theft. Police attended and issued the 41-year-old male and 42-year-old female with a trespass notice. The merchandise was returned to the business.

Theft

A representative of a local retail business reported having detained a male for theft. Police attended and issued the youth subject with a trespass notice and returned the merchandise to the business.

A local retail business reported four female subjects stole approximately \$740 worth of merchandise. The merchandise was recovered and contained a wallet (possibly belonging to one of the suspects.) The four subjects left in a vehicle (description provided to police.) This matter is still under investigation.

Missing backpack

A person reported their friend's backpack (which they had in their authorized possession) had been stolen while they were caring for the friend's child at a playground. The bag contained two sets of vehicle fobs, a wallet containing identification cards and credit cards and some baby items.

Possible fraud

A person reported a possible bitcoin fraud. The person was advised to contact Alberta Securities Commission to report the fraudulent activity.

Threat with weapon

A representative of a local restaurant reported a male (known and breaching a trespass notice) outside the restaurant causing issues and threatening customers. Police attended and located and arrested the male subject for possession of a dangerous weapon, uttering threats and breaching a Common Law Peace Bond. The subject was transported and housed at Camrose Police Service cells.

Counterfeit bill

A local bank reported an unknown person passed a \$20 counterfeit bill which was included in a deposit. Later in the week a representative of a local convenience store attended Camrose Police Service and turned in a \$20 counterfeit bill that was passed by an unknown customer.

Breach of Peace

Several people reported a female and male arguing outside of a local business, and that the female assaulted the male. Police located the female and arrested her to prevent a further breach of peace. The female was charged with assault and released from custody.

Theft

A Loss Prevention Officer of a local retail business reported having detained a female subject for theft. Police attended and issued the female with a trespass notice. The merchandise was returned to the business.

Impaired driving

A representative of a local business reported a male appeared to be passed out in a running vehicle. Police attended and observed the male passed out in the driver's seat of the running vehicle. The male provided police with a breath sample test which he failed. The male was issued with an Immediate Roadside Sanction and the vehicle was towed.

Warrants

Police conducted a traffic stop for a suspected impaired driver. The 19-year-old male operator of the vehicle was given an alcohol screening test and was issued an Immediate Roadside Sanction and violation tickets. The vehicle was towed.

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THE **MORNING BITE**

Hoisin Pork Belly

Melt-in-mouth fatty pork in a sweet and spicy glaze.

Prep time: 5 min

Cook time: 1 hr 15 mins

Servings: 2

Ingredients

400g high fat pork belly (no skin)

large thumb of ginger

4 cloves of garlic

1 scotch bonnet chili

2 tbsp ketchup

2 tbsp hoisin sauce

2 tbsp honey

2 tsp sesame oil

1 spring onion

Directions

Cut pork belly into 1 inch cubes.

In a small frying pan place pork cubes fattiest side down in dry pan, put gas on lowest level possible flame, cover with lid. Ideally your pork covers the entire surface of the small pan—crowding is good for this recipe.

Lard will render out of the pork allowing it to confit cook in its own juice. Low flame essential. Turn the pork 3 or 4 times until all sides are golden and fat is rendered to melt in mouth levels. This will take around 1hr.

Remove pork belly and place in a bowl and cover. Remove around half the liquified lard and store for other uses.

Add diced ginger, smashed garlic cloves and chopped chili and sauté in the remaining lard. Once these are softened add the ketchup, hoisin sauce and honey. Reduce over very low heat for a few minutes until thickened.

Add the pork belly to the sauce and cook on low for a further 2 minutes. Leave to stand for 5 minutes then add thinly sliced spring onions to garnish. Enjoy with steamed white rice.

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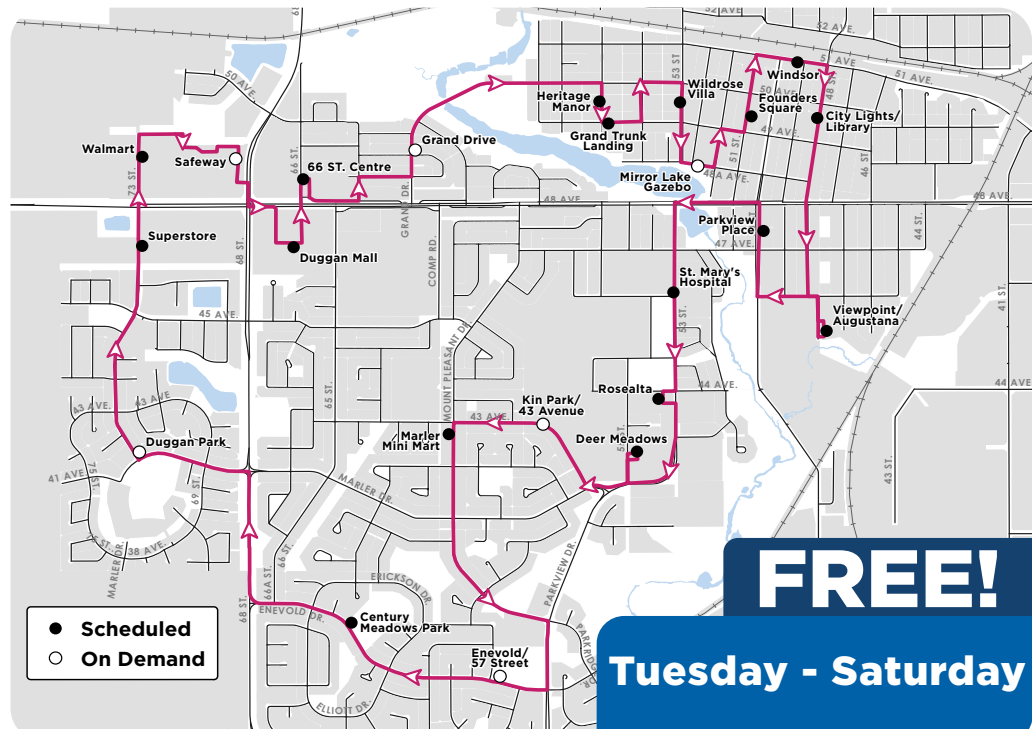

“Raising outdoor pasture pigs has always been a dream of mine, and in 2016 that dream became a reality when I imported two Red Mangalita pigs from California and EH Farms was born.” – Christina Stender

AOTP: How did you get into farming?

CS: I obtained a Bachelor of Science in Agriculture -Animal Science degree from the University of Guelph focused on swine production. I am also active in community support and sit on the Economic Development Board in Wheatland County where I bring my energy and knowledge of growing an agricultural operation in the region.

Along with my husband, Andy and our two boys, we bought a little 14-acre cattle farm and converted it into an amazing outdoor pig paradise. We are located just 30 minutes east of Calgary outside Strathmore in the County of Wheatland. We are considered pioneers in introducing the Red Mangalitsa pig to Canada thus creating a niche market. We also raise chickens, quails, ducks and laying hens for extra fun!

Throughout the year, our family farm host culinary events and farm tours to introduce urban visitors to aspects of the Mangalitsa and farm life. Based on the dedication and care that goes into raising livestock, I share our story about life on the farm and the vital role agriculture plays. I enjoy reconnecting people with their food, and where it comes from, especially with Mangalitsa pigs.

AOTP: Why Mangalitsa pigs?

CS: After doing some homework, the Mangalitsa pig shined above all the other breeds. They were the perfect fit for our climate and family farm. Like us they are a rare and unique breed! The Mangalitsa originates from Hungary; they are the fattiest pigs in the world, and are renowned for charcuterie, salami and cured hams. Their meat is considered among the tastiest pork in the world. The meat is reddish, highly marbled with creamy white fat. It's high in Omega 3-6-9 and natural antioxidants. Mangalitsa lard is lighter, melts at a lower temperature and contains high levels of mono-unsaturated fat (the good fat), making the flakiest pastries.

AOTP: What does your operation look like now?

CS: Today Eh Farms has many followers on social media. Follow #eh_farms on Instagram, EH Farms on Facebook as we love sharing stories. We also have an amazing website: ehfarms.ca We currently have 43 Mangalitsas of which 13 are piglets born this past month. These little “bacon bits” are born with dark racing stripes on their backs which eventually start to fade at around three weeks of age, just like wild boar piglets. Our farm is divided up into sections; boar housing, teenager pens, weaned piglet pen, pregnant girls' pen and my personal favourite the farrowing barn.

Alberta on the Plate showcases the incredible bounty that is grown and produced across our beautiful province. Throughout the year, we celebrate and share the Alberta food story by introducing you to the people and businesses that grow, raise, create, and support the agri-food industry in Alberta. Every August during Alberta Local Food Week, Alberta on the Plate hosts a ten-day, province-wide dine around festival. Get more info at:


