**MARCH 1-7, 2026**

Police assisted EMS on three separate occasions with medical emergencies.

Police attended four collisions. No reported injuries.

**Notable incidents**

**Stolen vehicle**

A person reported their vehicle was stolen from their residence (while they were out of country.) This matter is still under investigation.

**Outstanding warrants**

Police conducted a traffic stop on a 38-year-old male known to have outstanding warrants. The male was arrested for \$600 worth of fines.

**Arrest without incident**

A person reported an unwanted known male subject was in their residence and was not leaving. Police attended the residence, the reporting person had left the residence. Police contained the area, as the male subject had a past of violence and instability towards the police. The 40-year-old male subject was arrested without incident and held in custody.

**Public intoxication**

A person requested police assistance with removing a known female subject from their residence. Police attended and arrested the female subject for public intoxication. During incarceration the 34-year-old female subject became combative with police and needed to be restrained. The female was charged with obstruction and two counts of assault on a police officer.

**Causing issues**

A representative from a local retail business reported several youth causing issues. Police attended and located the youth, served them with trespass notices and contacted parents.

**Damage to property and assault**

A person reported a (know-to-them) 41-year-old male causing damage to their personal property and assaulting another male. The male was arrested by police and later released when sober with an indefinite trespass notice to the home.

**Expired registration**

Police conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for expired registration. The driver of the vehicle was unaware the vehicle was unregistered. The registered owner was contacted and will be issued violation tickets for no insurance and no registration.

**Trespass**

Police observed a known male subject contravening a trespass order. When police approached the male, he became confrontational. Police were able to calm the male and subsequently arrested him for obstruction and trespassing.

**Equipment violation**

Police conducted a traffic stop for an equipment violation. The operator of the vehicle was charged with no registration, misuse of licence plate and not carrying a bill of sale.

**Breach of Release Order**

Police observed a passenger in a motor vehicle that had a 24-hour curfew. The vehicle was stopped and the 29-year-old male was arrested and charged with two counts of breaching his court order.

**Trespass**

While on patrol police observed a male in a business contrary to his Trespass Notice. The 33-year-old male was approached and became aggressive towards police the male was arrested and charged with obstruction and trespassing.

**Failed Field Sobriety Test**

Police conducted a traffic stop for a vehicle equipment violation and observed methamphetamine and a crack pipe with residue in the vehicle. The occupants of the vehicle were arrested. The 43-year-old driver of the vehicle failed a drug test and was charged accordingly. Tickets were also issued for no registration, no insurance and misuse of licence plates.

**Impaired driver**

Police received several reports regarding a possible impaired driver. Police located the subject vehicle, identified the operator of the vehicle and conducted tests for impaired driving. The 74-year-old male driver was charged with dangerous driving and other driving offences.

**Impaired driving**

Police conducted a traffic stop for equipment violations and observed the female operating the vehicle to be under the influence of alcohol. The 18-year-old female failed the roadside screening test and was charged with impaired driving.





## Potato vegetable kugel is a Passover favorite

When I think of kugel, I imagine a casserole of noodles, eggs and fruit. But for Passover I'm not a fan of Passover noodles, so I make this savory potato vegetable pudding instead. While it looks like a simple potato vegetable casserole, it tastes like a crispy pancake on the exterior and slightly custardy on the interior.

I use the food processor method, where I pulse the ingredients until the mixture resembles shredded potatoes and vegetables. It is much easier than shredding everything. First an egg and onion batter is processed and then the rest of the ingredients are added. The other technique used for the crispy exterior is to heat the baking dish with your preferred fat in the oven so that when the batter hits the dish the mixture begins to brown. As the kugel bakes the bottom and sides of the dish become browned and crispy. If the top of the kugel isn't as brown, you can always run the casserole under the broiler for a minute or two. Watch carefully so it does not burn.

While this is a classic Passover savory side dish, it is delicious served anytime of the year. It is a nice accompaniment to grilled or roasted meat, chicken or fish. I like the combination of potatoes, vegetables and onions here. My preferred fat is chicken fat in this recipe. I think it brings more flavor to the simple potato vegetable combination. If you want just potatoes, add another potato and remove the zucchini and carrots.

### Potato Vegetable Kugel (Serves 8 to 12)

5 large eggs  
 2 large onions, cut into 2-inch chunks  
 14 scallions, light green and white part only, sliced  
 5 medium baking potatoes, cut into 2-inch cubes  
 1 medium zucchini, cut into 2-inch chunks  
 2 medium carrots, peeled and cut into 2-inch chunks  
 2 teaspoons salt  
 1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper  
 1/2 cup matzo meal  
 1/2 cup melted unsalted butter, margarine, vegetable oil, or rendered chicken fat  
 2 tablespoons thinly sliced chives or green part of scallions, for garnish



1. Preheat oven to 400 F and place rack in upper third of oven.
2. Puree three eggs together with half of the onion and scallions in a food processor fitted with the metal blade, until the mixture is smooth and fluffy. Add half of the potatoes, zucchini and carrots and pulse until the mixture is finely chopped but still retains some texture. Place in a large mixing bowl. Repeat the process with the remaining ingredients.
3. Add the salt, pepper, matzo meal and 1/4 cup melted butter, margarine, oil or chicken fat and quickly process to combine. Do not over process.
4. Transfer to the mixing bowl and mix well so the mixture is nicely incorporated and not separated. Reserve. (You can test the batter for flavor at this point; heat a nonstick skillet on medium-high heat and add a tablespoon of oil to it. Spoon in a tablespoon of batter and cook on both sides until brown, about 4 minutes. Taste for seasoning; if desired add more salt or pepper to the batter.)
5. Place the remaining 1/4 cup butter, margarine, oil or chicken fat into a 9-by-13- inch baking dish. Place in the oven for about 5 to 7 minutes or until the fat is very hot. Remove from the oven with potholders and pour in the potato-vegetable batter. Spread evenly with a rubber spatula. Return to the oven and bake uncovered for about 50 to 60 minutes or until the top is nicely browned and crisp. Garnish with chives or scallions. Cut into squares and serve.




