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Camrose Police Service Monthly Crime Report - Sept. 2025

Crime Statistics Report Summary:

In September 2025, a total of 40 occurrences were reported across the eight crime indicators, representing an unprecedented low. This marks a 54% decrease compared to the five-year average for September, which stands at 87 occurrences.

The overall decline was primarily attributed to a significant reduction in property-related crimes. Property offences fell by 39% compared to the five-year average of 70 incidents. Specifically, substantial decreases were recorded in break and enters, thefts of motor vehicles, and theft under \$5,000. These categories showed reductions both in comparison to September 2024 and the five-year monthly average.

The downturn in these high-frequency property crimes is attributed to enforcement efforts, targeted patrols, offender management and community-based initiatives.

The **Recycling Roundup** is an opportunity for residents to responsibly dispose of a variety of materials, ensuring they are handled safely and sustainably.

Every household uses products in their home and garden that contain harmful chemicals. Any container that cautions about careful use of the product or disposal of the container should be included in the Hazardous Waste Round-Up.

Materials brought to the Roundup should be kept in their original containers. Broken or cracked containers should be placed inside leak-proof packages and labelled. Jars or cans of unidentified chemicals can also be disposed of—simply take them to the Roundup and tell a staff member that you are unsure of the contents.

The following items will be accepted, however to reduce program costs, the preferred recycling locations are:

- Paint at the **Landfill or Recycling Depot**
- Used Oil, Containers, and Filters at the **Landfill**

Stir-fried noodles, a versatile main dish

I am a noodle lover and this one is a favorite of mine. This is a fun recipe cooked in the wok or a deep skillet. Years ago, I worked with Chuck Williams of Williams-Sonoma on how best to describe the act of stir-frying — which is easy if you follow the directions. Remember that fresh noodles cook much faster than dried ones so be careful not to overcook them. They will be cooked again in the wok.

This delectable noodle dish is finished with a highly flavored peanut sauce. You can adjust the heat level by adding chili oil a little at a time. Make sure to use a blender or food processor or even a hand blender to mix up the sauce ingredients. The other important technique is to turn off the heat just before adding the peanut sauce, so it is just the right temperature to infuse into the noodles. This is especially good with lime and cilantro marinated and grilled chicken or tofu pieces placed on top.

Stir-Fried Noodles with Spicy Peanut Sauce (Serves 4 to 6)

For the sauce:

2/3 cup peanut butter
1/4 cup water
1/2 cup soy sauce
2 tablespoons sesame oil
2 tablespoons sherry
4 teaspoons rice wine vinegar
1/4 cup honey
4 medium cloves garlic, minced
2 teaspoons minced fresh ginger
1 tablespoon chili oil or to taste



For the noodles:

3 tablespoons peanut oil
2 medium carrots, cut into thin matchsticks
4 chives, cut into 2-inch lengths,
1-pound fresh Chow Mein noodles or packaged spaghetti noodles, boiled for 3 minutes or until al dente in boiling water and well drained

1. In a blender or food processor combine all the sauce ingredients and blend or process to combine. Taste for seasoning. Reserve.
2. In a wok or a deep saute pan over high heat add 2 tablespoons of peanut oil, swirling around to coat the sides. When the oil is very hot but not smoking add the carrots and toss every 15 to 20 seconds for about 3 minutes or until just tender.
3. Add 3 chopped chives and toss for another minute. Push the carrot and chive mixture up onto the side of the wok and add the remaining 1 tablespoon oil. Add the fresh noodles and cook for 2 minutes, tossing every 15-20 seconds with 2 forks or tongs to keep the noodles from clumping up or sticking together.
4. Turn off the heat and add the reserved peanut sauce to the wok and toss the noodles and the vegetables together to coat. Taste for seasoning. Garnish with remaining chives. Transfer to a serving platter or individual bowls and serve immediately. Or chill and serve as a salad.

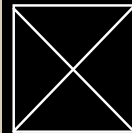

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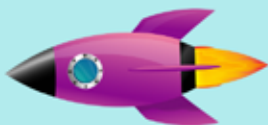

Every year, thousands of Albertans lose their eyesight because of problems with their retinas. If these problems aren't treated, they can lead to permanent blindness. Historically, retina treatments were hard to get and expensive. Over the years I have met a number of Camrose Constituency residents who have had to seek this type of treatment. Starting October 1, it's even easier for Albertans to get fast, high-quality eye care. That's because United Conservatives have made the Alberta Retinal Treatment Program permanent – and it's now completely free.

The program started as the RAPID pilot program in 2015, offering advanced eye injections to Albertans to protect their eyesight. 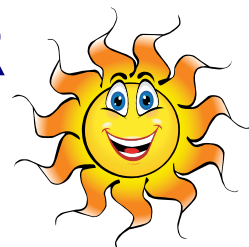
