Pedestrian struck

A motorist reported striking a pedestrian at the intersection of 47 Street and 50 Avenue. Pedestrian received minor injuries.

Investment scam

A person reported being a victim of an online scam that began with the purchase of a book (DeepSeek) about artificial intelligence, which turned into an investment scam where a person was sent to the victim's residence to pick up cash.

Dog attack

A resident reported an attack by a dog resulting in minor injuries to both herself and her dog. Community Peace Officer continues investigation.

Scams

A person reported being the victim of fraud by a caller claiming they needed money for medical concerns. Victim sent the person \$1,850 in gift cards.

Easy apple tarts to make this fall

These apple tarts look and taste like they came from the bakery but are so easy to whip up yourself. An ultra-flaky, buttery puff pastry crust frames tart-sweet Granny Smith apple slices, while the warm flavors from the fruit soak into the pastry. To prevent your apple tarts from becoming soggy, leave any juices from the apple slices behind in the mixing bowl.

Easiest Apple Tarts (Serves 6) Active Time: 25 minutes

Total Time: 1 hour, 15 minutes

1 frozen puff pastry sheet, thawed

1/4 cup packed light brown sugar

1/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1/4 teaspoon grated orange zest

1/8 teaspoon ground allspice

Pinch of salt

- 1 large granny smith apple, unpeeled, halved and cut into 1/8-inch slices
- 1 tablespoon unsalted butter, cut into 1/4-inch cubes
- 1 large egg, beaten
- 1 1/2 teaspoons apple jelly, melted

Powdered sugar for dusting (optional)

- 1. Position oven racks in upper and lower thirds of oven; preheat to 400 F. Line a rimmed baking sheet with parchment paper.
- 2. Unfold puff pastry sheet; cut in half. Place the halves 1 inch apart on the prepared baking sheet. Chill in the freezer, uncovered, for 15 minutes.
- 3. Stir brown sugar, cinnamon, orange zest, allspice and salt together in a large bowl. Add apple slices; toss until evenly coated.
- 4. Arrange the apple slices evenly over the pastry rectangles, leaving about a 1/2-inch border around the edges, overlapping slices as needed and leaving any excess juice in the bowl. Top the apples evenly with butter. Brush the pastry edges with egg.
- 5. Bake on the upper rack for 10 minutes. Rotate the pan 180 degrees and move to the bottom rack; bake until golden brown, puffed and the bottom is cooked through, 20 to 25 minutes, loosely covering with foil to prevent excess browning if needed. (The sugar mixture may deeply caramelize on the parchment but will not impact the tarts.)
- 6. Let cool on the baking sheet on a wire rack for 10 minutes. Brush the apples with melted jelly just before serving. If desired, dust with powdered sugar.

We are currently in Stage 1 of our 4-stage water shortage response plan. The following MANDATORY water restrictions are in place:

- Lawns may only be watered between 6AM to 9AM and 7PM to 11PM.
 - Odd-numbered houses may water only on odd-numbered days.
 - Even-numbered houses may water only on even-numbered days.
- Only hand watering with a watering can or hose with trigger nozzle is allowed for flower and vegetable gardens.
- Sprinklers and water toys may be used for recreational purposes by children as long as children are actively playing, including a pool with a capacity not more than 1,000 litres.
- Decorative outdoor water features must be turned off.



Understanding Grief...

Grief is a normal but sometimes overwhelming *emotion*. It is a response to the loss of someone or something that we have formed relationship or a bond with. There are many dimensions to this emotion that have impacts on our physical body, our cognitive functions, social interactions, and our spirituality. It is normal to find yourself feeling numb and removed from daily life, unable to carry on with regular duties while saddled with the sense of loss. Grief is both a universal and a personal experience. Individual experiences of grief vary and are influenced by the nature of the loss.

Experts advise those grieving to realize they can't control the process and to prepare for varying stages of grief. Understanding why you're suffering can help, as can talking to others and trying to resolve issues that cause significant emotional pain.

Mourning is the expression of *grief*, occurring as a result of someone's death. It is a personal and a collective response which can vary depending on the contexts of the relationships we have.

Ceremony is a unified ritualistic event with a purpose, usually consisting of a number of human expressions such as music, spoken word, poetry, or other artistic components. The purpose of a funeral ceremony is for those who are experiencing grief to come together in a meaningful way that allows for the expression of our grief. Every ceremony is as unique as the individual whose life we are celebrating. Some ceremonies may have rich traditions that incorporate religious or spiritual elements. Other ceremonies may be very simple and only have a few components. *The important thing is that grief shared is grief diminished* and ceremony's that allow for people to mourn together can greatly support our path to acceptance.
