#### Stolen items

A resident reported their Honda 3000 generator and two gas cans were stolen from their trailer located in the area of 6402 and 30 Avenue. Investigation continues.

#### Resisted arrest

Police conducted a vehicle stop for speeding. The female driver provided a false name. Police determined her actual identity and that she had no drivers licence, registration and insurance and misuse of licence plates. The female was placed under arrest for obstruction, possession of a prohibited weapon and possession of drugs (meth, GHB and prescription pills.) The female resisted arrest and failed a Drug Recognition Expert exam.

#### Stolen truck

A person reported their 2007 Chevy Silverado was stolen. Investigation continues.

#### **Damage to private property**

A person reported damage to their private property by a known female. Investigation continues.

#### Online fraud

A person reported losing \$4,800 to an online rental scam (Peace of Mind Rentals). Victim had viewed several rentals for residences online, signed a rental agreement for a residence and then e-transferred the funds. When they went to the location of the rental residence they spoke with neighbours who indicted that residence was not for rent but for sale. The online advertisement has since been removed. Investigation continues.

#### Stolen bike

A person reported their black BMX with red grip handles, stolen from the area of 4837-52A Street and indicated the theft was recorded on video. The bike was recovered and the investigation continues.

#### Major collision

Police responded to a report of a major collision on Highway 13 resulting in the closure of the highway in both directions. The offending vehicle made a U-turn in front of two lanes of oncoming traffic. Subsequently the vehicle was struck by a pickup truck. Two people in the truck were transported by EMS to hospital. Charges pending.

#### **Impaired driver**

Police conducted a traffic stop and as the vehicle pulled over it struck a parked vehicle causing minor damage to the parked vehicle. The driver of the subject vehicle blew a caution on a Mandatory Alcohol Screening Device. Police determined the driver to be a provincially suspended driver, issued tickets for driving while suspended, liquor within reach of the driver, and possession of illegal cigarettes. The subject vehicle was towed.

#### **Collision**

A person reported a collision involving their vehicle and a semi-truck. The operator of the other vehicle provided statements. Investigation continues.

#### Unlawful entry to vehicle

A person reported their vehicle was entered unlawfully in the area of 4623 and 65 Street. Household items, tools and documents (including registration and insurance) were stolen.

#### Unlawful entry to rental property

A rental property owner reported an evicted tenant entered their vacant rental property and on a later date entered again and was attempting to change the locks. Police conducted extra patrols of the subject property.

Collision causing damage to private property and injury

Person reported (911 call) a collision occurring at 4611 45 Street. A second 911 caller indicated some youth drove a vehicle into their neighours fence then left the scene running. Police located the male driver of the subject vehicle and six other youth involved. Police determined the diver was speeding in the alley and lost control, hit a transformer pole and then drove through the fence. Two of the seven youth involved were transported by EMS to hospital for injury as a result of the collision. Investigation continues.

#### False Id

Police conducted a traffic stop and determined the driver falsely identified themselves. Police confirmed actual identity of driver and that they were a suspended driver. Driver was arrested for identity fraud and obstruction and issued a ticket for driving while suspended.

#### Vehicle equipment violation

Police conducted a vehicle equipment violation stop resulting in arresting and charging the driver with driving while criminally suspended from driving.

#### Collision

Police attended a collision involving two vehicles at 49 Avenue and 48 Street. One female driver was charged with failing to proceed when safe to do so. Both vehicles were towed.

#### Theft from trailer

A person reported their work trailer had been broken into in the area of 6209 39 Avenue. Tools and rolls of electrical wire were reported stolen.

#### Unlawful entry to vehicle

Police received two reports of vehicle windows being smashed and purses stolen from the vehicles.







We are currently in Stage 1 of our 4-stage water shortage response plan. The following MANDATORY water restrictions are in place:

- Lawns may only be watered between 6AM to 9AM and 7PM to 11PM.
  - Odd-numbered houses may water only on odd-numbered days.
  - Even-numbered houses may water only on even-numbered days.
- Only hand watering with a watering can or hose with trigger nozzle is allowed for flower and vegetable gardens.
- Sprinklers and water toys may be used for recreational purposes by children as long as children are actively playing, including a pool with a capacity not more than 1,000 litres.
- Decorative outdoor water features must be turned off.
   Stage 1 includes exemptions for newly laid sod.

Any violation of these restrictions can result in fines.





#### Miso soup, a taste of Japan

I just returned from Japan. Out of the many things I tasted and enjoyed was miso soup. Each meal was accompanied with this delicious dish. Every soup had its own distinctive taste — some richer and darker, some lighter. Sometimes it was served at the beginning of the meal and others toward the end of the meal. I prefer it at the beginning of a meal.

While there are numerous miso soup mixes on the market, this recipe calls for making a dashi base first and then preparing the miso soup. The dashi base is an infusion of seaweed (edible kelp) and bonito flakes that becomes a very flavorful stock. Once you try this, you'll want to have the dashi available in your refrigerator for a quick and satisfying weekday meal. It's best to locate an Asian market for these ingredients.

Miso is a soybean paste, and there are a few types. Light yellow miso, called shiro miso, is used here for its slightly sweet flavor. You can also add tiny little clams to this soup. Other flavorings sometimes added to miso soup include sugar and rice wine, as well as dried seaweed.

#### Miso Soup (Serves 4)

#### For the dashi:

1/4 cup kombu flakes (seaweed)5 cups water1 cup bonito flakes

#### For the miso soup:

1/4 cup light yellow miso paste (shiro miso) 5 cups dashi 2 thin slices ginger 1 package enoki mushrooms, trimmed 1 cup 1/2-inch cubed firm tofu 2 tablespoons sliced scallions



#### To make the dashi:

- 1. In a large saucepan combine the konbu with cold water. Heat the mixture on medium heat until the soup comes to a slow simmer and not a boil. Remove from the heat, cover and let stand for about 5 minutes. Strain the konbu out of the broth and return it to another pan.
- 2. Reheat the dashi, making sure not to bring it to a boil or it will become bitter. When it is just beginning to simmer, remove it from the heat and add the bonito flakes. Once the flakes are submerged, let sit for 30 seconds. Strain the dashi into a container or pan and use for miso soup. Refrigerate, covered, until using.

#### For the miso soup:

- 1. In a large saucepan combine the miso paste, dashi and ginger; whisk to combine. Bring to a simmer on medium-high heat. Cover the pan and reduce the heat to low, allowing the soup to cook for about 3 minutes.
- 2. Remove the ginger. Add the mushrooms, tofu and scallions and bring to a simmer. Cook another minute or until the tofu is heated through and the mushrooms are just cooked. Taste for seasoning.
- 3. To serve: Ladle into serving bowls and serve immediately.



# MEET A PRODUCER Red Shed Malting

Penhold, Alberta

For the avid craft beer lover in Alberta, Red Shed Malting is a name that you often come across. Whether it's on a brewery posting about their latest collaboration, the side of a can as part of the ingredients or accumulating yet another Community Builder Industry Award at the Alberta Beer Awards, Red Shed Malting seems to be everywhere. That's no coincidence – with multiple generations of the Hamill family running all sides of the operation, there is no way you can enjoy craft beer in Alberta without hearing the name.

#### **Alberta Demand**

Red Shed Malting currently supplies a variety of malts to about half of the craft breweries in Alberta. Some of the breweries use their base malt to provide the sugars for the fermentation process, while others capitalize on their specialty malts to create a pantheon of beer styles that rivals any booming craft beer scene. The specialty malts are where Red Shed really shines.

At any given time, Red Shed has about sixteen different malt varieties. From their base malts like the Parkland Pale and Penhold Wheat Malt, to their Black Bird (the first black malt ever drum roasted in Alberta), they have a malt that is perfect for every craft beer. They will also do special contract malts, and even have a secret malt currently hiding out in an unlabeled bin!

One of the favourite collaborations they've done is with Blindman Brewing and 24-2 Draft Horses, a local farm that grow and harvest their malt-grade barley all by old-school horse-powered equipment. The barley is then custom malted by Red Shed to produce a complex but delicate English style malt. Blindman Brewing goes on to create the 24-2 Stock Ale, which is one of the most hyper-local beers to be produced, with it being locally grown, harvested, cleaned, malted, and brewed. Stock Ales are traditional British ales that are strong and fruity – closely related to barley wine. It's not a style typically seen in modern times, adding to the uniqueness of this collaboration. Some of last year's batch was also aged in a bourbon barrel with some Brettanomyces yeast, adding depth, oakyness, and funkiness into the flavour profile.

Their products are not only used by Alberta breweries, but also some distilleries as well. One of these, Bridgeland Distillery in Calgary, uses Red Shed Penhold Wheat and Barley to create a bourbon-style spirit that won gold at the Alberta Spirits Awards, and Silver at the Canadian Artisan Spirit Awards for Young Whisky. (The Barrel Aged 24-2 Stock Ale also won Gold at the 2021 Alberta Beer Awards.)

Alberta on the Plate showcases the incredible bounty that is grown and produced across our beautiful province. Throughout the year, we celebrate and share the Alberta food story by introducing you to the people and businesses that grow, raise, create, and support the agri-food industry in Alberta. Every August during Alberta Local Food Week, Alberta on the Plate hosts a ten-day, province-wide dine around festival. Get more info at:
