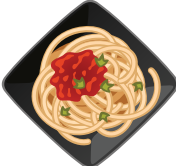

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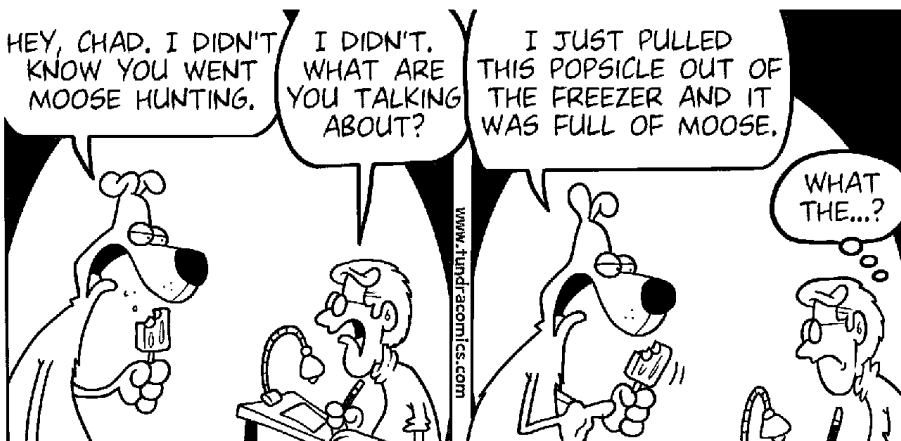

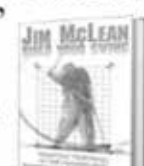
Give Yourself a Break!



Why am I badly missing so many “breaking” putts? We find amateur golfers tend to move their putter along a line toward the hole, rather than along the correctly “read” intended starting line of the break. So, way off, missed putt.

Here's a tip to help: Let's say you're facing a **10-foot** putt that you think will break **12** inches to the right. Imagine a hole on that line, just **3** feet away. Now align your putter to drain your putt right into the center of that imaginary hole but remember to stroke the putt with enough force to reach your **10-footer**. You'll be looking up and often watch your ball rolling into the cup or stop so close you're assured no worse than a “**2-putt**.”
