SEPTEMBER 1, 2025

Assault suspect located

Police located the male suspect involved in the assault on police officer (August 31). The suspect brandished a knife and threatened officers, fled on foot and tried to gain access to a police vehicle. Police deployed taser on suspect who was arrested and brought before a Justice of the Peace. A bail hearing was set for September 3.

SEPTEMBER 2, 2025

Attempt Grandparent Scam

A resident reported receiving a call from someone pretending to be their grandson who had been in an accident, was arrested for having drugs in their vehicle. The resident began asking questions and the caller hung up.

Open Liquor and suspended driver

SEPTEMBER 6, 2025

Possession of stolen medical products

ISD Reactivation and Reminder

On October 10, Camrose Police will be reactivating the Intersection Safety Devices (ISDs) located at the intersection of 68 Street and 48 Avenue.

After thorough examination of a business case presented by Camrose Police Service, the Provincial government granted approval for an exemption from the new Auto-

mated Traffic Enforcement (ATE) policy implemented on April 1 of this year, allowing Camrose Police Service to re-activate the ISDs.

These devices are used to monitor red light and speeding violations on both eastbound and west-bound traffic at the intersection of 68 Street and 48 Avenue.

Stage Restrictions



STAGE 1 Warning



STAGE **3** Emergency

We are currently in Stage 1 of our 4-stage water shortage response plan. The following MANDATORY water restrictions are in place:

- Lawns may only be watered between 6AM to 9AM and 7PM to 11PM.
 - Odd-numbered houses may water only on odd-numbered days.
 - Even-numbered houses may water only on even-numbered days.
- Only hand watering with a watering can or hose with trigger nozzle is allowed for flower and vegetable gardens.
- Sprinklers and water toys may be used for recreational purposes by children as long as children are actively playing, including a pool with a capacity not more than 1,000 litres.
- Decorative outdoor water features must be turned off.

 Stage 1 includes exemptions for newly laid sod.

Any violation of these restrictions can result in fines.

This 20-minute easy dinner is a snap to prepare

Brie Passano

This easy lemon-garlic chicken recipe calls for cutlets, which cook in less than 10 minutes. If you can't find them, make your own from chicken breasts.

Place each breast on a cutting board and, with your knife parallel to the board, slice into the skinny side of the chicken breast in a single smooth motion. The side of green beans is cooked right in the same pan as the chicken, so cleanup is a cinch.

Lemon-Garlic Chicken with Green Beans (Serves 4)

Active Time: 20 minutes
Total Time: 20 minutes

2 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil, divided

4 large eggs

1/4 cup finely chopped onion

1 (5-ounce) package baby spinach

3 cups arugula

1 tablespoon chopped fresh dill

1/2 teaspoon garlic powder

1/4 teaspoon ground pepper

1/8 teaspoon salt

4 whole-wheat English muffins, split and toasted

4 tablespoons crumbled feta cheese



- 1. Heat 1 tablespoon oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Break eggs, one at a time, into the pan. Cook until the whites are set but the yolks are still runny, 1 to 2 minutes. Break the yolks with a spatula. Flip the eggs and cook until just done, about 1 minute more. Transfer to a plate and cover to keep warm.
- 2. Add the remaining 1 tablespoon oil and onion to the pan. Cook, stirring often, until softened, about 1 minute. Add spinach and arugula in batches and cook, stirring, until wilted, about 4 minutes. Add dill, garlic powder, pepper and salt; cook, stirring, for 1 minute more.
- 3. To assemble sandwiches, place the eggs on the bottom halves of the English muffins. Top each with 1/4 cup of the spinach mixture, then sprinkle with 1 tablespoon feta (reserve excess spinach mixture for another use). Serve topped with the remaining muffin halves.


