AUGUST 17, 2026

EMS assistance

Police assisted Emergency Medical Services with gaining entry to an apartment to access a patient requiring medical attention. Police gained entry and the individual was subsequently left in the care of EMS.

Break and Enter , vehicle theft and arson investigation

Police responded to a report of a break and enter at a local business where a white truck had been stolen. The stolen truck was reported to have struck another vehicle and crashed through a gate before fleeing the area.

Police located the stolen truck a short time later engulfed in flames, west of the city. Camrose Fire Department, the Camrose Police Service RPAS (drone) unit and the RCMP Police Dog Service assisted in the investigation. Evidence at the scene suggested the fire was intentionally set.

Following the investigation, including the review of CCTV footage and evidence recovered by police, a 31-year-old male was arrested and charged in relation to the incident. The accused was lodged in Camrose Police Service cells pending a judicial hearing.

Driving While Unauthorized

While continuing into the investigation of the stolen truck incident(above), police conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle observed in the area. Investigation revealed the 30-year-old operator of the vehicle was operating the vehicle while his licence was provincially suspended. The subject of the vehicle was charged with Driving While Unauthorized and the vehicle was towed.

Causing disturbance

Police received several complaints regarding a male causing a disturbance in the Duggan Park area. Police located the 28-year-old male subject, who reported seeing a bear in the area. Patrols were conducted but no bear was located. Later in the evening, police received additional complaints involving the same subject. The male was arrested and lodged in Camrose Police Service cells until sober.

AUGUST 18, 2026

Contravening an Emergency Protection Order

Police received a complaint that a woman had attended a residence contrary to the condition of an Emergency Protection Order. Following an investigation the 25-year-old female attended the Camrose Police Service and was arrested for failing to comply with the order. She was later released on an Appearance Notice.

Outstanding warrant

Police observed a 42-year-old male subject wanted on an outstanding fraud-related warrant. The male was arrested, processed and released on an Undertaking.

Break and Enter

A local business reported a break and enter that occurred over the weekend. Investigation determined entry was gained through a broken window and a three-wheel bicycle was stolen. This matter is still under investigation.

Vehicle collision with minor injury

Police attended a two-vehicle collision on 65 Street. Investigation determined one vehicle was exiting a parking lot when it collided with a northbound vehicle. Emergency Medical Services assessed both operators of the vehicles involved, determining one sustained minor injury. The 26-year-old operator of the vehicle exiting the parking lot was charged with failing to proceed safely after stopping at an intersection.

Disturbing behaviour

Police received a report that an intoxicated male was acting suspiciously and causing concern in an alleyway. Police located the 32-year-old male, who initially refused to identify himself. Following police intervention, the male was identified and safely transported home.

AUGUST 19, 2026

Breach of Peace

Police responded to reports of a verbally aggressive male at a residence in the 4200 Block of 66 Street. While police attempted to issue a Trespass Notice, the male became uncooperative. The 47-year-old male was arrested for Breach of Peace, lodged in Camrose Police Service cells until sober and later issued a Trespass Notice.

AUGUST 20, 2026

Warrant arrest

During a traffic stop for a vehicle equipment violation, police determined the operator of the vehicle was wanted on an outstanding warrant. The 42-year-old male was arrested and transported to Camrose Police Service cells where he later resolved the warrant and was released.

AUGUST 21, 2026

Unwanted person

Staff of a local hotel requested police assistance regarding a male sleeping inside a dumpster on the property. Police attended, identified the male subject, who then left the area without incident.

Theft

A representative of a local business reported a theft from a secured compound. Investigation revealed a propane tank and extension cord had been stolen over a period of several days. CCTV footage was obtained. The matter is still under investigation.

Motor vehicle collision

Police attended a two-vehicle motor vehicle collision at the intersection of 50 Street and Camrose Drive. Approximately \$2500 in damage was sustained and no injuries were reported. The collision remains under investigation.

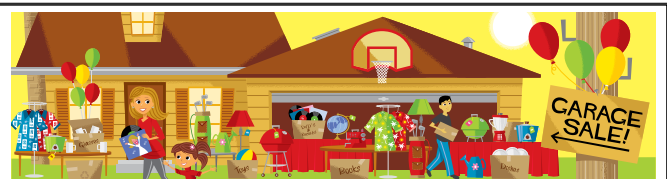

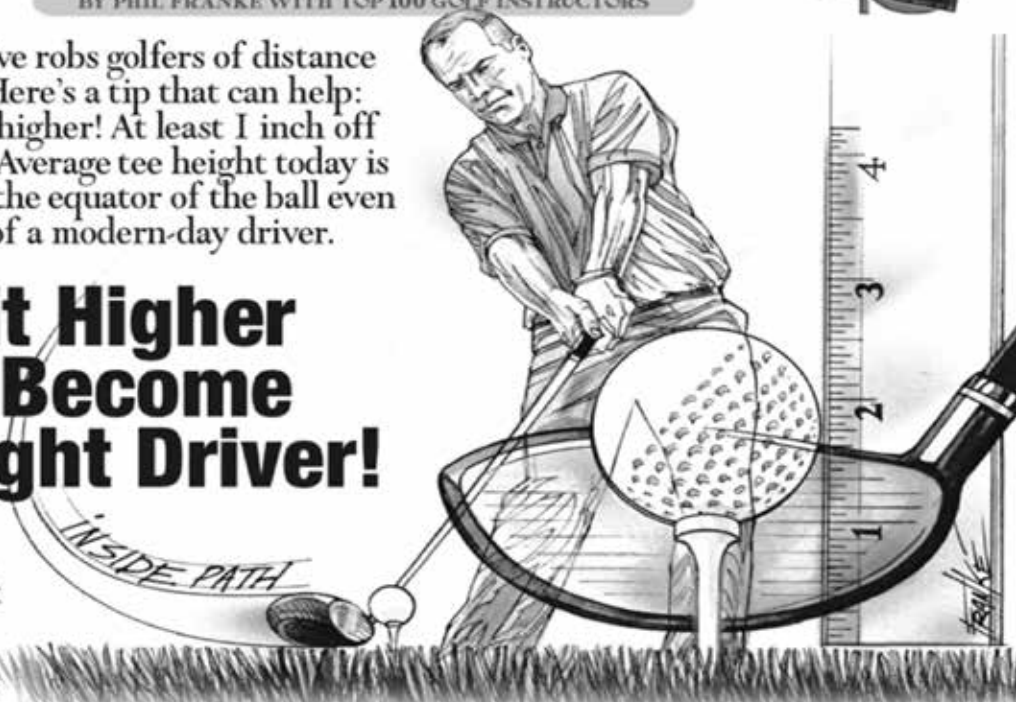
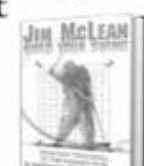

A “sliced” drive robs golfers of distance and accuracy! Here’s a tip that can help: Tee your ball up higher! At least 1 inch off the turf or more. Average tee height today is **1.5 inches**, with the equator of the ball even with the top of a modern-day driver.

Tee It Higher and Become a Straight Driver!

How can such a small adjustment reduce a slice? The higher you tee the ball, the more you must swing the club around your body, on a flatter plane to make square contact. This swing is more likely to make contact while moving from inside to along the target line rather than from the outside-in. This will give you a straight ball flight or one with a slight right-to-left draw shot. Tee it higher and you’ll like the results.

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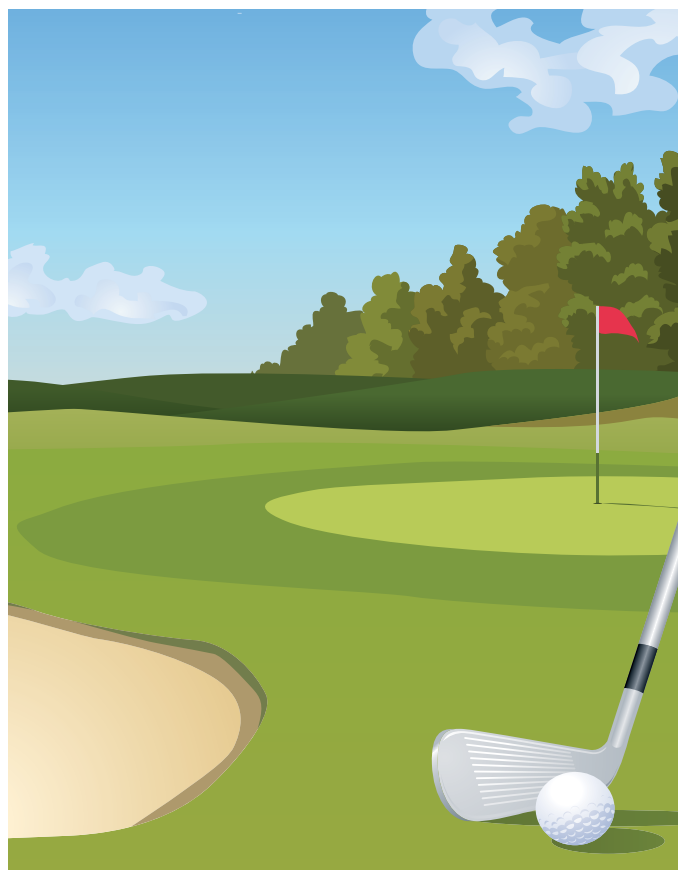

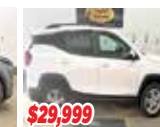

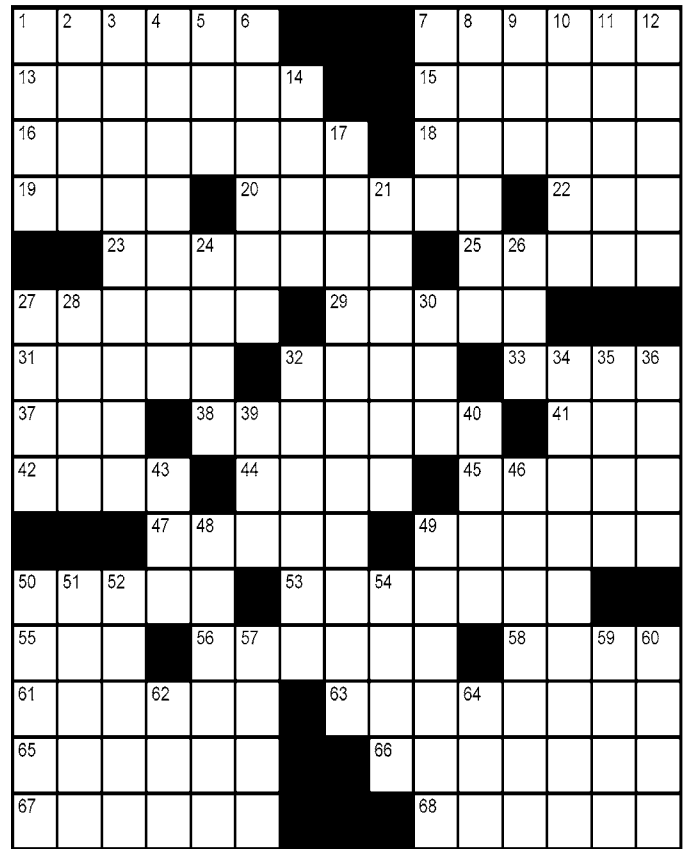

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Award-Winning Duo The Black Feathers to Bring “Magical” Stage Chemistry and Genre-Defying Harmonies to Camrose



Music lovers in Camrose are in for an intimate and “riveting” performance as award-winning UK duo The Black Feathers arrive in Camrose.

Comprising married singer-songwriters Ray Hughes and Sian Chandler, the pair bring a rare, profound stage chemistry built on a “telepathic understanding” that wraps audiences in their world from the very first note. Currently residing in Wales, UK, the Irish- and English-born musicians have been married in life and to the stage since 2012, touring extensively across North America and Europe.

Their sound seamlessly weaves together Americana, Folk, and Acoustic Indie Rock sensibilities into a “genre-defying” music style that feels both modern and ancient. Hughes’ intricate guitar work provides the ideal backdrop for their otherworldly vocal blend—a connection often reserved for family bands. Yet, The Black Feathers are equally adept at transforming classics with inventive covers, including a “sassy” acoustic take on Portishead’s “Glory Box.” The resulting sound captures a distinct “Country-got-Soul beauty” that balances emotional depth with effortless charm.

Beyond their technical virtuosity, it is their electric live presence that makes their concerts unforgettable. As Downend Folk and Roots noted, “When they sing, the world is a better place. When they really let rip, wars could stop, the sun could shine, peace could reign.”

Whether delivering heartbreaking ballads or soaring, high-energy acoustic anthems, The Black Feathers offer a live performance that promises to be one of the highlights of the local arts season.

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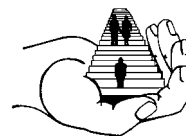

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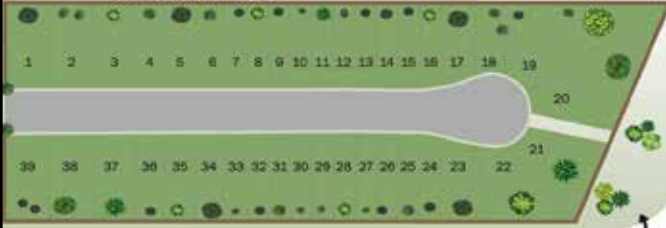

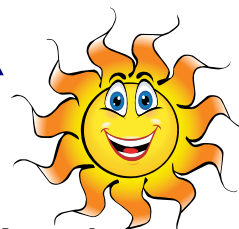
