





Grandparent/parent scam....Just hang up Camrose Police Service would like to warn residents of the Grandparent/Parent Scam that has

been recently circulating.

Police have received several reports from residents who have received a telephone call from someone using the grandchild or other family member scam to scam them out of their hard earned money.

The scammer will contact the victim by telephone (often a landline and often in the evening) posing as a lawyer or police officer, grandchild or other family member, indicating that they (grandchild or family member) are in some kind of trouble, in jail and need cash for bail.

In some instances the scammer will allow the victim to speak with the alleged loved one or actually impersonate the loved one by using a device to change their voice to replicate that of a loved one's voice. They may even ask if the victim knows who is calling, prompting the victim to divulge the name of a loved one, then use that name to complete the scam.

The scammer indicates that it is urgent, pressuring the victim into providing payment quickly by providing the victim with directions on how to pay, which may include a requested email money transfer or a pickup of the cash payment by a person the scammer indicates is a bail bondsman.

This is a scam.

Police, lawyers and court officials will never request an electronic money transfer or send someone to a place of residence for cash payment. Hang up from the phone call and contact Camrose Police at 780-672-4444 (complaints line). - Decorative outdoor water features must be turned off.
 Stage 1 includes exemptions for newly laid sod.

Any violation of these restrictions can result in fines.



A Mexican steak bowl is an easy dish for a weeknight dinner

All-in-one bowl entrees are a boon for the busy cook. I had lots of fun making this recipe with crowd-pleasing results.

This Mediterranean farro wheat grain is a happy surprise added to the traditional corn and black bean Mexican ingredients. Farro now can be found at Trader Joe's and other markets, partially cooked so it only takes 10 minutes to prepare — a Seriously Simple tip. If you can't find it, opt for traditional farro and follow the directions for cooking it. Make sure to cool the cooked farro to room temp for this recipe

I've made the marinade and dressing in one bowl and then divided it for both the steak and the finished salad. You can use your favorite cut of steak — New York, flank or rib eye — for this toothsome salad. I prefer the texture and quick cooking of skirt steak.

Cilantro has become an issue for some, so I always offer it on the side, chopped up, as a garnish. Feel free to jazz up the bowl with thin slices of ripe avocado or your favorite red or green salsa. The presentation and colors pop when you serve this in white bowls. Serve with chilled beer for a delicious combination.

Mexican Steak Bowl with Farro, Corn and Black Beans (Serves 4)

For the marinade and dressing:

1/4 cup fresh lime juice
1/4 teaspoon ground cumin

1/2 cup grapeseed or olive oil

1/4 cup store-bought Pico de Gallo or another red salsa Salt and black pepper

For the bowl:

1 pound skirt steak

6 cups cleaned and shredded light green and white romaine lettuce

1 cup cooked farro

1 ear shucked corn kernels (about 1/2 cup)

1 cup drained and rinsed cooked black beans

1 large ripe red tomato, diced

For serving:

3 tablespoons cotija cheese

Extra salsa, optional

2 tablespoons chopped cilantro leaves, optional

- 1. Combine the marinade ingredients in a small bowl and whisk to blend. Taste for seasoning.
- 2. Place the skirt steak in a plastic sealable bag or dish and pour over 1/4 cup of marinade. If the skirt steak is in one piece cut in half so it can evenly be marinated. Cover or seal. Refrigerate for 2 to 8 hours.
- 3. While the steak is marinating, transfer the lettuce to a salad bowl. Arrange the farro, corn, black beans and tomato on top of the lettuce. Cover and refrigerate if not using immediately.
- 4. When ready to serve: Heat the grill pan on medium high and grill the steak about 3 minutes per side or until medium rare. Remove from pan onto a carving board, cover with foil and let rest for 10 minutes. Then carve the steak into 1/4-inch slices and set aside.
- 5. Pour enough dressing over the salad and toss to evenly lightly coat the ingredients. Place the salad in individual bowls, arrange the steak slices on top and sprinkle with cotija cheese. Serve remaining dressing and extra salsa on the side. Cilantro is optional.

Alberta is growing quickly, and that means we need more reliable and affordable electricity. Families, farmers, and local businesses here in the Camrose Constituency and across the province rely on a steady source of power to keep the lights on, run equipment, and grow our economy. That's why United Conservatives are launching an important conversation with Albertans about the future of our energy system – and whether nuclear energy should be a part of it.

Nuclear power is already being used in other parts of Canada and around the world. It's a safe and reliable way to produce energy without adding pollution to the air, and it can help meet our growing energy needs while supporting efforts to reduce our emissions. It also has the potential to create good jobs and power new industries that could benefit Alberta's communities for generations.

This fall, our United Conservative government is launching a phased public engagement on nuclear energy. In the first phase, an expert panel has been chosen to hear directly from Albertans. This panel, made up of respected leaders from business, universities, and Indigenous communities, will gather feedback and give advice on how Alberta could use nuclear energy in the future.

Right now, every Albertan can share their opinions by filling out the Nuclear Engagement Survey at Alberta.ca/Nuclear-Energy-Engagement, which is open until September 25. Later this year, the panel will start holding in-person meetings across Alberta, and there will be even more chances to get involved through 2026.

In 2022, Alberta teamed up with Saskatchewan, Ontario, and New Brunswick to look into small modular reactors and other nuclear technologies. These new, smaller reactors are being considered in many places, and it is important to see if they could be a good fit here in Alberta.

As your MLA, I want to hear from you. This is about our future. I encourage everyone in the Camrose Constituency to take a few minutes to fill out the survey and make your voice heard.
