I make batch after batch of this 'magical' secret sauce

If you're in a dinner slump, I have a solution that is 100% guaranteed to excite your taste buds. The secret to turning bland chicken breast and boring baked fish into something that you actually look forward to eating is adding a sauce. Restaurants add flavor-packed sauces to simple proteins to elevate their menus every day, and there's no reason why you can't do the same.

There's a sauce for every flavor, from a sunny lemon-butter to spicy Viet-Cajun and beyond. The sauces that I rely on most often are made from ingredients that I always have on hand that up any protein I'm serving it with. One of my favorites is my honey garlic sauce. Made with fresh garlic, sweet honey, savory soy sauce, and tangy vinegar, it makes everything I spoon it on delicious. What's even better is that it comes together in just 10 minutes.

Key ingredients in honey garlic sauce

Honey: Honey adds sweetness and body to the sauce.

Garlic: You'll need 4 garlic cloves for this recipe.

Soy sauce: This recipe was tested with regular soy sauce and tamari. If you use the low-sodium version, you may need to add additional salt to taste.

Vinegar: A splash of acid balances the flavor of this sweet and savory sauce. Use apple cider, rice, or distilled white vinegar.

Cornstarch: An optional slurry of cornstarch and water thickens the glossy sauce, helping it cling to your food.

Honey Garlic Sauce (Serves 4)

1/4 cup honey

2 tablespoons soy sauce or tamari

2 teaspoons apple cider vinegar, rice vinegar, or distilled white vinegar

1/4 teaspoon red pepper flakes (optional)

2 teaspoons neutral oil, such as vegetable or canola oil

4 cloves garlic, minced

For thickening (optional)

1/4 cup water

2 teaspoons cornstarch



- 1. Whisk 1/4 cup honey, 2 tablespoons soy sauce, 2 teaspoons apple cider vinegar, and 1/4 teaspoon red pepper flakes if using together in a small bowl.
- 2. Heat 2 teaspoons neutral oil in a small saucepan over medium heat until shimmering. Add 4 minced garlic cloves and cook until fragrant, about 30 seconds. Whisk in the honey mixture. (If you'd like a thicker sauce, whisk 1/4 cup water and 2 teaspoons cornstarch together, then whisk into the sauce at this point.)
- 3. Cook, whisking occasionally, until bubbling rapidly and the foam darkens slightly in color, 1 to 2 minutes.

Recipe note: Refrigerate leftovers in an airtight container for up to four days.





We are currently in Stage 1 of our 4-stage water shortage response plan. The following MANDATORY water restrictions are in place:

- Lawns may only be watered between 6AM to 9AM and 7PM to 11PM.
 - Odd-numbered houses may water only on odd-numbered days.
 - Even-numbered houses may water only on even-numbered days.
- Only hand watering with a watering can or hose with trigger nozzle is allowed for flower and vegetable gardens.
- Sprinklers and water toys may be used for recreational purposes by children as long as children are actively playing, including a pool with a capacity not more than 1,000 litres.
- Decorative outdoor water features must be turned off.
 Stage 1 includes exemptions for newly laid sod.

Any violation of these restrictions can result in fines.
