## LOCAL POLICE REPORT

#### **AUGUST 23-29, 2025**

Police received a report of a disturbance and assault. Suspect was arrested and lodged in police cells to be released on Undertaking when sober.

Police received a report of items being taken from a front porch of local residence. Police investigated and determined suspect. Items were returned.

Recently police have received several complaints of vehicles and sheds that were entered during the night. Police would like to remind residents to ensure vehicles and other property are secure while unattended.

Police received another report of an attempted Grandparent Scam, where scammer identified themselves as a lawyer requesting \$6,800 bail money to release a relative from jail. The victim did not comply and contacted police immediately.

Police received a report of a possible impaired driver. Police located the vehicle subject of the complaint. Driver was given a Field Sobriety Test (FST) and passed.

During an early morning patrol police observed a group of young persons that fled when they saw the police. Police located and arrested two subjects for breaching court conditions and trespassing on private property.

During patrol police observed known suspect with outstanding warrants. During arrest and search of suspect, police seized three knives contrary to suspect's release order.

Police responded to a complaint of an abandoned vehicle which turned out to be stolen. Registered owner was notified.

Police conducted traffic stop on vehicle for stunting and summons was issued. Passenger of vehicle was issued a ticket for having open liquor in motor vehicle. Passenger became non-compliant and was arrested for public intoxication. Police responded to complaint of disturbance. Subject, who was impaired by alcohol and non-compliant, was arrested for breach of peace.

Police conducted stop on vehicle for traffic infraction. Driver failed Field Sobriety Test (FST) was issued a summons and IRS suspension.

Police observed a truck towing a trailer travelling at excessive speeds and failing to stop for a red light. Traffic stop was attempted. The subject vehicle fled at a high rate of speed. Police unit disengaged to mitigate risk to public.

Police received a report from another victim of the Grandparent Scam. Victim was instructed by scammer to bring \$5,000 cash for bail money to a fake lawyer. The victim did meet with the individual and turned over the money.

Police responded to report of a suspect setting fire to grass on the north side of Mirror Lake. Person reporting incident indicated they extinguished the fire, but subject of complaint was still in area. Police located subject and arrested them for arson and causing property damage. Subject was charged with arson, mischief and breaching a release order.

Police initiated traffic stop on subject in contravention of a condition to not operate a motor vehicle. Subject had outstanding warrants was arrested and issued summons' and released on an appearance notice.

Police received a report from a victim of the Grandparent Scam who was contacted by a fictitious lawyer requesting bail money to release a relative from custody. The victim reported they were defrauded out of \$49,200. The victim reported they were contacted by the scammer everyday for over a week.

Police conducted high visibility check stop. No concerns regarding driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

So his wife sent him back a harmonica, saying, "Why don't you learn to play this?"







We are currently in Stage 1 of our 4-stage water shortage response plan. The following MANDATORY water restrictions are in place:

- Lawns may only be watered between 6AM to 9AM and 7PM to 11PM.
  - Odd-numbered houses may water only on odd-numbered days.
  - Even-numbered houses may water only on even-numbered days.
- Only hand watering with a watering can or hose with trigger nozzle is allowed for flower and vegetable gardens.
- Sprinklers and water toys may be used for recreational purposes by children as long as children are actively playing, including a pool with a capacity not more than 1,000 litres.
- Decorative outdoor water features must be turned off.
   Stage 1 includes exemptions for newly laid sod.

Any violation of these restrictions can result in fines.

#### This is the easiest way to cook eggplant

Cooking eggplant is quite easy and works in a million different ways: grilled eggplant, roasted eggplant cubes, stir-fried eggplant, and stuffed eggplant, to name a few.

But whenever fall rolls around I find myself consumed by an abiding drive to cook everything in the oven. And baked eggplant is one of the best and easiest things to do!

#### Why you'll love it

This method is incredibly easy. With very little prep (and no peeling!), you're rewarded with tender eggplant that you can use for any dish.

It's so versatile. Baked eggplant is a delicious side dish with roasted chicken or seared steak. Or scoop it out for baba ganoush or a hearty pasta sauce.

#### Types of eggplant for baked eggplant

Globe eggplant: You'll need two medium eggplants or 1 large eggplant. If you're using one large globe eggplant, it may be necessary to salt it before roasting. After scoring the eggplant, simply sprinkle it liberally with kosher salt and let stand for 30 to 60 minutes. Then rinse off the salt, give it a firm squeeze to get rid of any excess juices, and pat dry with a paper towel.

Japanese eggplant: If you're using a long, skinny, Japanese eggplant, it is not necessary to score or salt it. Just cut it in half and pop it in the oven.

#### What to make with baked eggplant

Baba ghanoush: Scoop out the eggplant and make this smooth and creamy dip.

Stuffed eggplant Parmesan: A spin on classic eggplant Parmesan, stuffed into a hollowed-out eggplant shell and topped with melted mozzarella.

Roasted eggplant sabich bowl: A hummus bowl topped with roasted eggplant, tomato-cucumber salad, tahini sauce, and jammy eggs.

Eggplant Parm pesto: Roasted eggplant is blended with a garlic-oregano-and-tomato paste olive oil, then blitzed with fresh basil and lots of Parmesan.

#### Baked Eggplant (Serves 2 to 4)

2 medium eggplants or one large globe eggplant Olive oil Kosher salt Freshly ground black pepper

- 1. Preheat oven to 400 F.
- 2. Cut the stem end and bottom off two medium eggplants or one large globe eggplant, then cut it in half lengthwise. Score the flesh with a knife, cutting deep into the flesh but not through the skin. Cut diagonal lines going about an inch apart, then turn the eggplant around and cut again so you have a diamond pattern.
- 3. Brush the eggplant flesh with a bit of olive oil and put it face-down on a baking sheet.
- 4. Bake for 35 to 40 minutes, or until the back of the eggplant looks collapsed and puckered.
- 5. Let the eggplant cool for 10 minutes, then season with salt and pepper. It can be scooped out of the peel for use in dips, or eaten plain with its antioxidant-rich peel and a sprinkle of lemon juice.




